

**THE CANADIAN SLEEP AND CIRCADIAN NETWORK ANNOUNCES
TRAVEL FELLOWSHIPS TO ATTEND THE
3RD CONFERENCE OF THE CANADIAN SOCIETY FOR CHRONOBIOLOGY**

Overview. A major objective of the *Canadian Sleep and Circadian Network (CSCN)* is to develop the careers of Canadian trainees engaged in sleep and circadian research. To reach this objective, the CSCN is proud to open a Travel Fellowship Competition for trainees who will present their research and attend the 3rd Conference of the Canadian Society for Chronobiology (CSC), which will take place at York University (Toronto, ON, Canada) on May 19-21, 2017. The 3rd Conference of the CSC is a scientific event where trainees and postdoctoral fellows will have many occasions to enrich their scientific network, will be given opportunities to attend career development sessions taking place during the Mini-School, as well as the chance to present their work during oral or poster sessions.

The goal of the CSCN Travel Fellowships is to provide support to undergraduate and graduate students, as well as to postdoctoral fellows conducting clinical or basic science research to attend the 3rd Conference of the CSC. The fellowships will be awarded to full-time trainees conducting research at any accredited Canadian university, and be between \$100 and \$500 to support travel expenses (e.g., train, flight, gas, hotel) and/or registration fees. Original receipts will need to be provided to the CSCN after the Conference for the payment of the fellowship.

Application Process: Interested trainees should submit by **April 1st 2017** the required documents detailed below as a single PDF file to **Dominique Petit** (dominique.petit.1@umontreal.ca). All applications will be reviewed by members of the CSCN Training Committee and of the CSC Program Committee.

Required Documents:

- 1) The abstract submitted for presentation to the 3rd Conference of the CSC (including full names of authors and institutions);
- 2) A short paragraph describing the need for funding (250 words maximum);
- 3) A proof of registration to the 3rd Conference of the CSC.
- 4) Original receipts (after the Conference).
