



## University of Calgary Advanced Fellowship in Sleep Medicine

The University of Calgary and Foothills Medical Centre offers a 3 year fellowship in Sleep Medicine. The primary objective is to provide comprehensive training that will facilitate an academic career in Sleep Medicine.

The fellowship provides advanced clinical training in Sleep Medicine and the opportunity to participate in an established research program.

Trainees who complete the Fellowship will satisfy requirements for the proposed Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Area of Focused Competence (AFC) in Sleep Disorders Medicine.

Applicants are required to have completed sub-specialty training in Respiratory Medicine with certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) and be eligible for medical licensure in Alberta (requires completion of the Canadian LMCC exams).
