



**University of Calgary Advanced Fellowship
in
Sleep and Neuromuscular Respiratory Medicine**

The University of Calgary Division of Respiriology and Foothills Medical Centre Sleep Centre offers a two-year Fellowship in Sleep Medicine with specialization in Neuromuscular Respiratory Disorders.

The Fellowship provides advanced clinical training in Sleep Medicine with a particular emphasis on respiratory care related to neuromuscular disorders, chest wall restriction and chronic ventilation.

Trainees who complete the Fellowship will satisfy requirements for the proposed Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Area of Focused Competence (AFC) in Sleep Disorders Medicine.

Applicants are required to have completed sub-specialty training in Respiratory Medicine with certification from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) and be eligible for medical licensure in Alberta (requires completion of the Canadian LMCC exams).
